The screencasting

After your device(s) and TV Box are connected to the same network, the screencast logo will show up in the related applications of your device(s). Click the screen cast logo and share the photos, music, and videos on TV.

TV learning functions

- 1. Press the blue power key for 5 seconds until the LED indicator lights constantly.
- 2. Press the desired key found in the blue section that you wish to program (LED will begin to flash indicating that it is ready to be programmed).
- 3. While both remotes face one another, press and hold the desired programming key on the original TV remote for 1-2 seconds.
- 4. The LED will flash and the key has been programmed. You can choose another key by repeating steps 2 and 3.
- 5. Once complete, simply press OK at the center of this remote to exit learning mode.
