Buttons and indicators configuration

- Power On/Off switch: Slide switch to power the keyboard on or off
- Connect button: Next to the Power button, Connect button allows you to connect the keyboard with your tablet.
- Power indicator: When you turn on the keyboard, it will light up for 4 seconds, and then it will go off
- Bluetooth indicator: When you press the Connect button, this indicator will start blinking until it connects to the tablet. Once connected, it will stay on while connected.
- Caps lock: Upper case and lower case letters; when it's on, the keyboard will type all upper case letters.
- Charging indicator: This indicator stays on while the keyboard is charging.

Charging

When the battery is low, the power indicator light will flash, which means that the keyboard needs to be recharged. To recharge it, connect one end of the USB cable to the keyboard and the other end to the power adapter or a PC USB interface. The charging indicator will light up while charging, and when the charging is done, the indicator will turn off.

Bluetooth keyboard connection steps

- 1. Power on the keyboard and press the Connect button. The Bluetooth indicator will start flashing, which means the keyboard is ready to pair with your tablet.
- 2. On your tablet, go to the settings, open Bluetooth, and turn it on.
- 3. From the list of available devices, select the Bluetooth keyboard, type the PIN code displayed on the screen, and press Enter.
- 4. After the pairing is successful, the pairing status will be displayed on the Bluetooth screen, and you can start using the keyboard.
